You will be completely responsible for the care of your horse/pony as well as taking part in a whole range of fun activities. The week culminates in Show Day on Friday where there will be competitions such as Show Jumping, Working Hunter, Tack and Turnout, Handy Pony and Chase me Charlie – all appropriate to your level. We welcome spectators on show day!

Participants may bring their own horse/pony. There are also riding school horses/ponies available.

Each day starts at 7.30am on the yard – everyone must sign in on arrival each day.

Participants are divided into small groups (maximum 8) according to age and ability. Each group has two riding sessions per day.

Other activities may include:

- Stable management
- Grooming
- Horse/pony care
- Preparation for badges/certificates

Each day ends at 8.00pm after evening activities. Everybody must sign out before leaving the premises

Cost - £250

This includes:

- Instruction in small groups
- Fully supervised activities (daytime and evening)
- All meals and refreshments
- Stabling/accommodation, hay and water. Please bring any extra hard feed that is needed for your horse/pony

Places are limited and allocated on a first come first served basis. **Payment by cash** or debit card only please

- A non-refundable £100 deposit together with completed registration forms must be received by 1st May
- Balance of £145, together with all other completed forms must be received by 1st June
- Payment and/ or forms not received by 1st June will result in loss of the place and deposit

Early submission of forms and payment is strongly advised and appreciated. All forms must be signed and completed by 1st June Please note that each participant will require a separate set of forms

Camping

All participants are welcome to camp overnight from Monday to Friday. Trentvalley Equestrian LLP are unable to offer overnight supervision facilities. To satisfy the insurance policy at Trentvalley as well as child protection and safety requirements you will need to make arrangements for a parent/ guardian/ any other responsible adult to stay overnight 8pm – 7am each night with any under 18s wishing to camp.

If you wish for your child to be supervised by another responsible adult you must fill in and return the 'Letter of Supervision' form completed so that Trentvalley Equestrian LLP's insurance is valid.

Please note:

- Camp staff (instructors/ workers) are unable to act as overnight supervisors.
- Please do not ask adult participants to act as overnight supervisors
- All adults acting as overnight supervisors are required to complete the 'Child Protection Policy Certification' Form
- We will check that the appropriate arrangements have been made or we will be forced to call you to come and collect your child.
- Parents/ carers should indicate on the appropriate form their night of supervision.
- If you are nominating someone else to stay on your behalf you must indicate who this is and which night they are staying.

If you are unable to stay with your under 18 (or arrange supervision) we regret that your child will be unable to camp overnight.

Camping set up times (4-6pm Sunday)

- You must provide all of your own camping equipment
- Tents may be erected in the designated area on the afternoon of the Sunday before (4pm-6pm) but <u>nobody will be allowed to stay overnight</u>
- All tents should be removed by Friday evening. Please be aware that there is a show jumping competition that evening.
- Trentvalley Equestrian LLP accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to any camping or personal equipment.
- Toilet/washing facilities are basic. New in 2017! Shower facilities!
- All campers must be in tents by 10pm latest
- Lights out at 10.30pm
- Get up at 7am each morning
- Please note that there is a zero tolerance no smoking policy across the whole premises. This includes the camping area

What you need to bring

Every participant needs to be properly equipped for the week. Some items are optional however most are essential.

EVERYTHING must be indelibly labelled with the participant's name.

Please note that due to the large number of participants, we cannot provide individual storage facilities. You must be personally responsible for all of your belongings. Trentvalley Equestrian LLP accepts no responsibility for loss of damage to any of your belongings.

Everyday Riding Attire

- Trentvalley sweatshirt/ T-Shirt/ White shirt
- Jodhpurs navy/ black/ cream
- Suitable footwear riding boots/ muckers/ wellingtons
- Body Protector must be worn for all jumping
- Riding Hat to current BHS safety standard (please consult a member of staff well in advance if you are not sure whether your hat conforms)
- Toiletries
- Swimming things (including towel)
- Casual wear for the evening jeans/trainers etc.
- Long sleeves must be worn for jumping

Friday Show Day

- White shirt
- Pony Club Tie
- Cream Jodhpurs
- Jacket (V-necked pullover if you do not have one)

For your horse/ pony (this applies to all participants including those using a school horse/pony)

- Full Grooming Kit
- Saddle soap
- Hoof oil
- Head collar and lead rope (Essential)
- Hay net
- Sponge
- Wheelbarrow and tools (if you have them)

If you have your own horse/pony you are responsible for providing all tack etc associated with your horse/pony.

Overnight Campers

- Bedding
- Clothes
- Toiletries (toilet/ shower facilities are basic)

Meals

All meals are included for all participants and will be professionally prepared and served from the catering unit in the indoor arena. You must provide your own cutlery, crockery and cups.

At each meal there will be drinks and a choice of food including vegetarian. Please notify us of any specific dietary requirements on the camp registration form.

Breakfast

Varied choice including hot breakfast, cereal, toast, fruit and yoghurt etc.

Choice of sandwiches, salad, baked potatoes, quiches, fruit cakes etc.
