Entries are only accepted on this basis.
2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards.
3. All competitors not riding a Trentvalley school horse must have their own third party cover.
4. Safety Rules - Failure to comply with safety rules will result in elimination
5. **Photography**- By entry to this competition competitors agree to being photographed by the Official Photographer and give permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in activities at Trentvalley to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of Trentvalley Equestrian Centre.
6. **Hats** of all competitors must conform to current hat standards PAS 015, VG1, SNELL
Hats must be worn with chinstrap fastened at all times when mounted.
7. **Body Protector** – All competitors must wear a body protector that meets BETA 2009 Level 3 standard (purple label)
8. **Dress**: Cross Country colours permitted. Long sleeves compulsory
9. The organisers reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any class and reserve the right to disqualify anyone for the misuse of whip or spurs dangerous riding or any horse in poor or lame condition, and to refuse any entry for any reason and at their sole discretion.
10. The Judges decisions are final. Objections may only be made by riders and must be submitted to the Secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the discrepancy occurring, accompanied by a deposit of £10. The deposit only to be repayable if an objection is upheld.
